

Wakefield High School SMART Lunch 2010-2011

The Basics

- SMART Lunch will last for 55 min from 10:24 – 11:19.
- SMART Lunch is divided into two halves, A and B. There will be a bell halfway through to signal the switch. At this midway bell, students should go from lunch to an activity (tutorial, intramurals, media center, etc) or from an activity to lunch.

When & Where to Eat

- **Off-Campus Lunch:** Juniors and seniors with approved lunch passes will be allowed to leave campus for lunch. All students leaving campus must show their off campus lunch passes before they can leave the parking lot. **The driver of the car is responsible for any student riding in that car – make sure everyone has a lunch pass with them!!**
 - The bus lot exit onto Falls will be opened during lunch and will permit a left turn onto Falls. There will be staff in the parking lot to help direct traffic and check passes at each exit.
 - Some local restaurants are offering specials during SMART Lunch. These will be displayed each day on the rolling announcements.
- **On-Campus Lunch:** Those who remain on campus can go to the cafeteria during either the first half (A-lunch) or the second half (B-lunch). To help prevent excessive crowding in the cafeteria, please try to go to A-lunch if your last name begins with A-K and go to B-lunch if your last name begins with L-Z. If you have a tutorial session that you need to attend during one half, you may go to the cafeteria during either part. In the cafeteria, everyone must be *seated* at a table or standing in line.
 - No standing or sitting on the short walls around the cafeteria.
 - No “hanging out” in the cafeteria – you need to be seated, in line, or moving to another destination
 - There will be 5 lunch lines . . .
 - 2 lines on the sides in the front for hot lunches
 - 1 line in the middle front for sandwiches, salads, etc
 - 1 L-shaped pizza line toward the back
 - 1 “grab-and-go” kiosk with sandwiches, cookies, chips, etc near media center
 - You may eat outside in the courtyard near trailers #1-8, outside in the courtyard near student services, in the locker bays on the 1st and 2nd floors only (as long as they are kept clean), and in teacher classrooms (*with teacher permission*). Please be respectful and quiet while in the hallways since club meetings and tutorials will be going on in the classrooms.
 - You are NOT permitted to eat or hang out in the hallways or stairwells or on the 3rd floor.
 - Staff will be located in all areas around campus to help direct you to your destination.
- **Designated Outdoor Locations**
 - You **may** eat and hang out in the courtyard outside trailers 1-8 and the courtyard near student services. You may **not** hang out in the parking lot, on the tennis courts, on the basketball courts, on the fields, or in the stadium.

Activities :

- **Tutorials / Assignment Make Up**
 - Teachers and Departments will be offering tutorials, homework help, and assignment make up opportunities according to the days listed on the schedule.
 - You will need to sign in when attending tutorial sessions. You will be allowed to serve 30 min of ASD hours for each SMART Lunch tutorial session attended and documented.
 - Tutorials are not a time to simply hang out with friends in a classroom. Anyone not doing work, studying, making up tests, etc may be asked to leave the classroom.
- **Intramurals**
 - Intramurals will be available on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays each week.
 - Sign-ups will occur each day outside Coach Cooley’s office – you may sign up for either A or B lunch. There is a limit of 30 students per location per half of lunch. Students will be required to leave intramurals at the midway bell. You must present your ID to participate.
 - During A lunch only, the small gym will be open for such activities as table tennis, badminton, etc. When weather permits, other outdoor activities will be available during B lunch.

- During both lunches, the large gym (or outside depending on activity) will be used for organized activities such as basketball, volleyball, flag football, general fitness, etc. A schedule will be posted in advance.
 - Students are not permitted to enter any of the athletic facilities without being properly signed up for intramurals. Entrances and exits will be limited to the hallway next to the coaches' office/ Coach Cooley's office.
 - There will be no access to any locker room area and we are not responsible for any misplaced valuables.
 - Proper footwear is essential for intramurals. No boots, sandals, flip-flops or dress shoes are permitted
 - Absolutely no food or drink allowed in the athletic wing during lunch; this will lead to an automatic dismissal from intramurals.
- **Media Center**
 - The media center will be available for students to use every day, the entire SMART Lunch period for academic pursuits such as study, research, tutorials, or homework. No passes are required to enter the Media Center.
 - Standard Media Center policies will apply during SMART Lunch
 - The Media Center is an academic area; social activities should be relocated elsewhere.
 - Computer priority will be given to those students who have academic work to complete.
 - If a student is in violation of policies, he/she will be asked to leave for the day.
- **Club Meetings**
 - Clubs that do not include ninth graders may meet during SMART Lunch. Club advisors will submit a request for days of meetings. The club meeting schedule will be posted as soon as it is available.
- **Counseling**
 - Throughout the year, there will be different opportunities scheduled through the counseling department – small groups, college planning, career counseling, on-site admissions, etc. Please look for postings on the SMART Lunch Bulletin Board as well as the Student Services office for these activities.
- **Other activities**
 - There are many other opportunities that will present themselves as we go forward during the year. Please pay attention to the announcements and refer to the SMART Lunch bulletin board for upcoming events.
